C1 British English Course

This course is designed for advanced learners of the English language in the British English variant. The course is designed around the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) guidelines for C1 level descriptors.

The course comprises 11 units (plus an additional revision unit) and provides components of theory, production, and free practice of the four skills of language learning: Speaking, Listening, Reading, and Writing.

Each unit focuses on a discrete function, grammar topic, lexical set, or a combination these, and are assessed at the end of each unit in speaking and writing assignments designed for the learner to produce and personalise the target language as the course progresses.

The course uses a range of multimedia; including flash animation, video, audio, virtual classes and written texts, to provide an authentic context for language learning.

* Key language functions include: introducing oneself / others, expressing abbreviations, acronyms, and personal titles, organising ideas, expressing resemblance, making suggestions, polite requests, and offers, giving speeches, expressing regrets and wishes, expressing ability, prohibition and permission, describing objects, shapes, and materials, giving advice, describing pictures / art / colour, expressing large numbers, fractions, statistics, weight, and measurement, and expressing opinion.

* Key grammar topics include: present continuous vs. present simple, past simple vs. past perfect, past perfect simple vs. past perfect continuous, wh- pronouns, prepositions of movement, time, and place, indirect questions, articles, structures for expressing future, future perfect / continuous, omission, adjective order, gradable and non-gradable adjectives, used to / would + infinitive, as vs. like, indefinite pronouns, quantifiers, modals of probability, ability and speculation, past modals, had better / would rather, time phrases, gerund vs. infinitives, imperative, conditionals, passive voice, causative, relative clauses, reported speech, dependent prepositions, cleft sentences, inversion, and participle clauses.

* Key vocabulary topics include: professions, adjectives for describing jobs, Am.E vs. Br.E, theatre, books and authors, adjectives for describing physical appearance, parts of the face / body, adverbs of manner, illnesses, idioms / informal expressions, loanwords, phrasal verbs, collocations with 'have', confusing verbs, animals, shapes, materials, fabrics, clothes, patterns, expressions with 'get', natural disasters, the paranormal, compound adjectives, colours and related idioms, art, onomatopoeia, adverb / adjective collocations, space.
